On May 10, 2017 at approximately 2:15 pm detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division arrested Paul Emond, age 65, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, New Hampshire and charged him with Duty to Report and Duty to Inform, Both Class A Felonies.

In June of 2012 Paul Emond was convicted of Indecent Exposure and Lewdness in Hillsborough County Superior Court – South. The conviction requires Emond to register as a Tier I Sexual Offender biannually. Additionally, in August 2014 Emond was convicted of Duty to Report, Class B Felony, in Hillsborough County Superior Court – South.

In April, 2017, Detectives assigned to monitor Sexual Offenders who reside in Nashua discovered Emond failed to report to register as required by the terms of the Sexual Offender Registry. Further investigation determined that Emond moved from his previously reported address and failed to inform the Nashua Police Department as required.

Based on the investigation, it was determined that Paul Emond was non-compliant with the terms of the Sex Offender Registration and detectives applied for and were granted a warrant for Emond's arrest. Emond was arrested by detectives who happened across him at a downtown coffee shop. The offenses are charged as a Class A Felonies based on Emond's prior conviction for Duty to Report.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fourteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines for each count. Paul Emond refused bail and is being held pending his arraignment at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on May 11, 2017.
