On April 3, 2018 at approximately 3:13 p.m., officers arrested Madilyn Regis, age 21, of 18 River Road Apt. b, Hudson, New Hampshire, on a warrant for Receiving Stolen Property, Class B Felony.

On January 23, 2018, the Nashua Police Department was contacted by a victim of a theft that occurred in Connecticut. The victim believed the suspect(s) in the theft were from the Nashua area. Working with police in Connecticut, officers were able to confirm the theft and locate stolen items belonging to the victim which were sold by Regis to secondhand dealer in Nashua on December 26, 2017.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Regis was released on \$5,000.00 personal recognizance bail pending her arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on Thursday, April 26, 2018.
