On Friday January 20, 2017, at approximately 5:00 p.m., members of the Nashua Police Department's Patrol Division arrested Sebastian Fandino, age 22, of No Fixed Address, Queens, New York and Juliana Gonzalez, age 23, of 20-22 120 Street, College Point, New York, for one count of Theft by Unauthorized Taking, Class A Misdemeanor.

On Friday January 20, 2017, Patrol Officers responded to Abercrombie and Fitch at the Pheasant Lane Mall for the report of a shoplifting in progress. Loss Prevention recognized two individuals as suspects in other area Abercrombie and Fitch thefts and contacted the Nashua Police Department. Patrol Officers made contact with the two suspects and conducted an investigation. During the investigation it was discovered that the two suspects had stolen over \$500.00 worth of cologne from the Nashua Abercrombie and Fitch. It was also learned the two had over \$6,000.00 dollars in stolen Abercrombie and Fitch cologne in their vehicle.

The Criminal Investigations Division was notified of the incident and furthered the investigation. As a result, detectives were able to corroborate that they had stolen cologne from other Abercrombie and Fitch locations in Massachusetts. As a result both were also charged with one count of Receiving Stolen Property, Class A Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to 1 year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Both Fandino and Gonzalez are being held on \$10,000 cash bail at the Hillsborough County House of Corrections pending arraignment at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on January 23rd.
