On May 3, 2017 at approximately 5:09 PM, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau, Patrol Division, arrested Andrew Pike, age 23, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Duty to Report, Class B Felony.

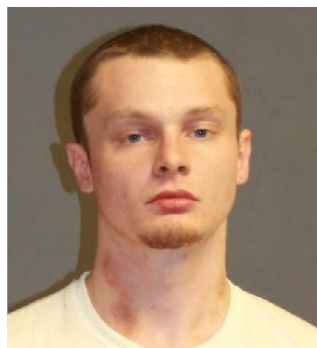
During a routine compliance check on Registered Sexual Offenders who reside in Nashua by detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division in March of 2017, it was determined that Andrew Pike had failed to comply with the terms of the Sex Offender Registry. Following the detective's investigation, it was determined that Pike failed to register on time as required in February 2017 and a warrant was obtained for his arrest.

Pike was convicted of Sexual Assault in Hillsborough County Superior Court – North in July 2014. Based on that conviction, Pike is required to register bi-annually as a Tier II Sex Offender for the remainder of his life.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Andrew Pike refused bail and is being held at Valley Street Jail pending his arraignment at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on May 4, 2017.
