On September 28, 2022, members of the Nashua Police Department Problem Oriented Police (POP) Unit arrested Leonardo Antonio Mckanobb-Hadley, age 18, of Nashua, New Hampshire, on an active arrest warrant for Possession of Child Sexual Abuse Images, a Class A Felony.

In February of 2022, Nashua Police Department received information from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC) regarding the exploitation of children via the internet. The Cyber Crimes Against Children Unit furthered the investigation and identified Mckanobb-Hadley as the suspect. During a search of Mckanobb-Hadley's residence, electronic devices were located and forensically examined. Upon that forensic examination, police located child sexual abuse images.

As a result of the investigation, an arrest warrant was issued, and Mckanobb-Hadley was arrested on September 28, 2022. Mckanobb-Hadley was released on personal recognizance and will be arraigned in the Hillsborough County Superior Court South on a future date. A class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines.
