On June 29, 2018 at 6:12 p.m., Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Brian Clegg, age 31, of Hudson, New Hampshire for Second Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony.

On January 9, 2018 the Nashua Police Department received a report of a domestic assault. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation and Brian Clegg was identified as the suspect. The adult victim reported that Brian Clegg placed both of his hands around her neck and squeezed to the point where her breathing was impeded. The victim and Clegg are known to one another.

Following an investigation, Detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Clegg for Second Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony. He was also charged with two counts of Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault-Domestic Violence, Class A Felony, two counts of Simple Assault-Domestic Violence, Class A Misdemeanor, and two counts of Criminal Threatening, Class A Misdemeanor.

Each Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Each Class B Felony is punishable up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Clegg was held on \$50,000 cash bail and will be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court South on July 2, 2018.
