On June 12, 2018 at approximately 9:19 AM, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau, Patrol Division, arrested Thomas Martel, age 30, of Concord, New Hampshire on a warrant for Duty to Report, a Class A Felony.

The Nashua Police Department was notified that a convicted Sex Offender did not complete his semi-annual registration in February 2018 with the Nashua Police Department as required by law. An investigation was initiated by the Special Investigations Division. Following the investigation, it was determined that Martel failed to complete his semi-annual registration with the Nashua Police Department and a warrant was obtained for his arrest. Martel was charged with one count of Duty to Report, a Class A Felony.

Martel was convicted of Felonious Sexual Assault from Coos County Superior Court on February 3, 2009. Based on that conviction, Martel is required to register semi-annually as a Tier II Sex Offender for the remainder of his life. Martel was also convicted of Duty to Report on December 15, 2011 in Coos County Superior Court in Lancaster, New Hampshire. Thus any subsequent offense of Duty to Report or Duty to Inform is a Class A Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Thomas Martel refused bail and is being held pending arraignment on June 13, 2018.
