On Wednesday December 28, 2016 at approximately 2:25 a.m., members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniformed Patrol Division arrested Calvin Degreenia, age 30, of No Fixed Address Nashua, New Hampshire, for Burglary, Class B Felony.

On December 28, 2016, Patrol Officers responded to a downtown business for the report of a burglary in progress. A witness had contacted the Nashua Police Department and reported they viewed a male subject enter the back of a closed business. Patrol Officers arrived on scene and viewed Degreenia inside the building. Degreenia then fled the building and was placed under arrest by Patrol Officers. Degreenia was placed under arrest for one count of Burglary, Class B Felony, one count of Resisting Detention, Class A Misdemeanor, and one count of Resisting Arrest, Class A Misdemeanor.

The Criminal Investigations Division was assigned to further this investigation and identified two other locations which Degreenia broke into earlier that evening. As a result Degreenia was charged with two more counts of Burglary, one Class A Felony and one Class B Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines and a Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to 1 year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Degreenia refused bail and is currently being held at the Hillsborough County House of Corrections pending his arraignment.
