On January 25, 2017 at approximately 6:04 pm, members of the Uniform Patrol Division arrested Jessica King, Age 31, of no fixed address for Criminal Liability for the Conduct of Another-Robbery, Class A Felony.

On January 14, 2017 at approximately 12:12 am, members of the Uniform Patrol Division responded to a Temple Street address for a stabbing. The victim reported that an unknown male entered his apartment and threatened to stab him if he did not give him money. The victim tried to fight off the attacker and suffered two stab wounds during the altercation. The suspect then fled and the police were called. The victim sustained non-life threatening injuries and was treated at a local hospital for his injuries. Members of the Criminal Investigation Division furthered the investigation and Brandon Mason, Age 26, of no fixed address was arrested for Robbery, Class A Felony, two counts of First Degree Assault, Class A Felony, and Convicted Felons, Class B Felony on January 14, 2017. The investigation also revealed that Jessica King was present at the time of the incident and helped Brandon Mason commit the robbery by letting him into the victim's apartment. Detectives obtained an arrest warrant charging King with one count of Criminal Liability for the Conduct of Another-Robbery, Class A Felony. She was arrested without incident by the Nashua Police Department Problem Oriented Policing Unit on January 25, 2017.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years in New State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years in New Hampshire State Prison, exclusive of fines. Mason was being held on \$100,000 dollars cash bail pending his next court date. King was held on \$100,000 cash bail pending her arraignment in the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on January 26, 2017.
