On September 27, 2022, members of the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Police (POP) Unit arrested Adam Earl Egerton, age 27, of 16 Coburn Ave., Nashua, New Hampshire, on an active arrest warrant for Possession of Child Sexual Abuse Images, a Class A Felony.

In February of 2022, Nashua Police Department received information from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC) regarding the exploitation of children via the internet. The Cyber Crimes Against Children Unit furthered the investigation and identified Egerton as the possible suspect. Upon forensic examination of electronic devices belonging to Egerton, police located child sexual abuse images.

As a result of the investigation, an arrest warrant was issued and Egerton was arrested on September 27, 2022 without incident. Egerton was held on preventive detention pending an arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court South on September 28, 2022. A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines.
