On June 12, 2017 at approximately 3:23 am, officers arrested Wilfrid Labrecque, age 36, of 4 Benson Avenue #2, Nashua, New Hampshire. Labrecque is charged with Driving Under Influence of Drugs or Liquor, Class B Felony, two counts of Domestic Violence; Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor, and two counts of Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor.

On June 12, 2017 at approximately 2:39 am, officers responded to the intersection of Burke Street and Benson Avenue for the report of a motorcycle accident. Labrecque was located on scene and was determined to be the only person involved in this motorcycle accident. He sustained minor injuries. Labrecque was subsequently placed under arrest for Driving Under Influence of Drugs or Liquor after showing signs of impairment. Labrecque was found to have been convicted of three previous Driving Under Influence of Drugs or Liquor offenses which resulted in him being charged with a felony. The Criminal Investigation Division was assigned to further this investigation and it was later learned that Labrecque was involved in a domestic dispute prior to the accident and was subsequently charged with the other offenses.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class A misdemeanor is punishable up to one year imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Wilfrid Labrecque was released on \$2,500.00 cash or surety bail and was arraigned in the 9th Circuit – District Division-Nashua Court August 9, 2017.
