On November 8, 2017 at approximately 6:51 PM, Detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division, arrested Richard Newton, age 38, of no fixed address, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Duty to Inform, Class B Felony.

The Nashua Police Department was notified that a convicted Sex Offender had moved out of an address in Nashua without properly updating his Sex Offender Registration information. An investigation was initiated by the Special Investigations Division. Following the Detective's investigation, it was determined that Newton failed to report a change to his information as required and a warrant was obtained for his arrest. Newton was charged with one count of Duty to Inform, a Class B Felony.

Newton was convicted of Lewd and Lascivious Acts in Ocala, Florida on June 4, 2009. Based on that conviction, Newton is required to register quarterly as a Tier III Sex Offender for the remainder of his life.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Richard Newton's bail was set at \$1,000 cash only and is being held at the Valley Street Jail pending arraignment on November 9, 2017.
