On May 7, 2017 at approximately 4:47 AM members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Scott Duplessis, age 45, of Nashua, New Hampshire. Duplessis was charged with Domestic Violence – Criminal Threatening; Criminal Threatening; Domestic Violence – Second Degree Assault; and Second Degree Assault, all class B Felonies.

On May 6, 2017 at approximately 10:00 PM, a woman reported a domestic violence incident that had taken place two weeks prior in Nashua. The woman, who was known to Duplessis and in a relationship with him, reported to officers that Duplessis threatened her with a knife. Detectives with the Special Investigations Division were notified and furthered the investigation. Detectives also determined that Duplessis struck a nine year old female in the face and caused non-life threatening injury to her. Duplessis is related to the child.

Based on the investigation, detectives applied for and were granted an arrest warrant for Duplessis charging him with Domestic Violence – Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony. Duplessis was located and arrested by patrol officers without incident. Duplessis was also charged with Criminal Threatening; Domestic Violence – Second Degree Assault; and Second Degree Assault, all class B Felonies.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State prison, exclusive of fines. Duplessis was held on \$12,500 cash only bail pending his arraignment at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on May 8, 2017.
