On May 8, 2019, at 9:44 am, members of the Nashua Police Department arrested Autumn Calciano, age 20, of 7 Harrison Road Bridgton, ME charging her with Theft by Unauthorized Taking or Transfer, Class A Felony.

On October 28, 2018, at 2:17 am, patrol officers responded to a residence in Nashua for the report of a theft of cash. Detectives were notified of this incident and furthered the investigation. Calciano was identified as the suspect and an arrest warrant was obtained for her arrest. Calciano and the victim are known to one another.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen (15) years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Calciano was released on personal recognizance bail and is scheduled to be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on May 23, 2019.
