On May 10, 2019 at 1:36 a.m., members of the Nashua Police Department arrested Joshua Fournier-De Jesus, age 31, who has no fixed address, for First Degree Assault, Class A Felony and two counts of Simple Assault, both Class A Misdemeanors.

On May 10, 2019 at 12:42 a.m., officers responded to the area outside of 235-237 Main Street, for the report of an assault involving a knife. After an initial investigation Fournier-De Jesus was identified as the suspect and was subsequently placed under arrest. Fournier-De Jesus is charged with punching, kicking and striking a male victim with a knife during the incident. The victim suffered serious but non-life threatening injuries and was treated at a local hospital.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Each Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Fournier-De Jesus is being held without bail pending his arraignment at Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on May 13, 2019 at 1:00 p.m.
