On February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at approximately 2:28 PM, Officers from the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing Unit arrested Natalie Anderson, age 33, of 37 Manchester Street Apt. A, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Acts Prohibited; Sale of a Controlled Drug, Methamphetamine, a Special Felony. On March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021 at approximately 4:06 PM, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Brian Fedion, age 38, of 37 Manchester Street Apt. A, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Acts Prohibited; Possession of a Controlled Drug w/ Intent to Distribute, Heroin/Fentanyl, Subsequent Offense, a Special Felony.

Beginning in November 2020, Detectives from the Narcotics Intelligence Division began an investigation into the distribution of narcotics from 37 Manchester Street Apt. A. As a result of this investigation which included the execution of a search warrant at 37 Manchester Street Apt. A, Detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Anderson and Fedion. Anderson was placed under arrest on February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021 by officers from the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing Unit and Fedion was placed under arrest on March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021 by officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau. Additionally, Anderson was charged with Acts Prohibited; Sale of a Controlled Drug, Methamphetamine, a Special Felony - Acts Prohibited; Possession of a Controlled Drug w/ Intent to Distribute, Heroin/Fentanyl, Special Felony – and Dealing or Possessing Prescription Drugs, Gabapentin, a Class A Misdemeanor.

A Special Felony is punishable by a maximum term of life in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to a year at the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Anderson and Fedion were released pending their arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court South.
