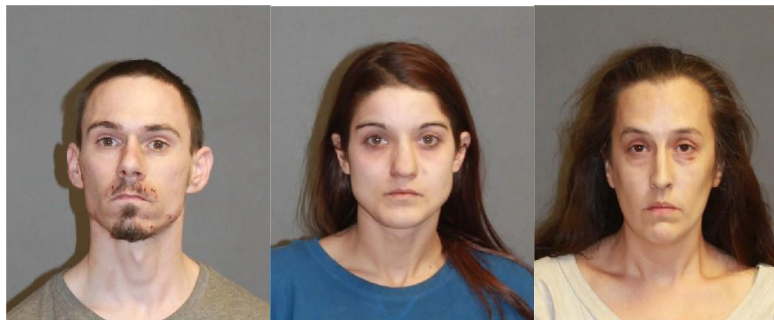

On February 1, 2018, members of the Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division, Problem Oriented Policing Unit, and Traffic Unit participated in Operation Granite Shield where three individuals were arrested for various drug crimes, and various crimes frequently associated with criminal behavior related to drug activity. These individuals were: Zachary Madison, Brittney Bellino and Jennifer Dion.

Brittney Bellino, age 25, of 95 Powers St Apt 26, Milford, NH, and Zachary Madison, age 26, of no fixed address, were both arrested during the same incident. They were each charged with one count of Acts Prohibited; Sale of a Controlled Drug, Heroin, Felony. The alleged sale of Heroin occurred in close proximity to a very young child, which resulted in each defendant being charged with one count of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Misdemeanor. Bellino and Madison were both held on \$30,000 cash bail and are scheduled for arraignment on February 2, 2018.

Jennifer Dion, age 35, of 11 Fletcher St Apt A, Nashua, NH was arrested and charged with one count of Acts Prohibited; Possession of a Controlled Drug, Crack Cocaine, Felony and one count of Falsifying Physical Evidence, Felony. Dion was released on \$10,000 cash or surety bail.
