On February 3, 2021, at approximately 11:17 am, members from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Yesther Pascual, age 19, of Nashua, New Hampshire, for two counts of Second Degree Assault – Domestic Violence, Class B Felony, and one count Criminal Mischief, Class A Misdemeanor.

On February 2, 2021, the Nashua Police Department received a report of a domestic incident involving Pascual and an adult female known to him. The investigation was furthered by Detectives assigned to the Special Investigations Division. During the investigation, it was determined Pascual and the adult female had been involved in a physical altercation and Pascual had damaged property of hers. Following the assault the female went to a local hospital for and was later released. Pascual was charged with two counts of Second Degree Assault – Domestic Violence, Class B Felony and one count of Criminal Mischief, Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B Felony is punishable up to 7 ½ years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to 1 year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Pascual was held without bail pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on February 4, 2021.
