On March 12 and 13, 2019, members of the Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division, Problem Oriented Policing Unit, and Traffic Enforcement Unit participated in Operation Granite Shield where nine people were arrested for crime associated with drugs. Arrested were Aaron Jones, Emmanuel Colon, Chad Landry, Miguel Perry, Breana Groves, Ryan Luther, Christopher Kerr, Mariah Peters, and Dwayne Griffith.

Aaron Jones, age 43, of 108 North Street, Claremont, New Hampshire was arrested for Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug, Heroin, Felony, stemming from a drug investigation within the city of Nashua. Jones was released on bail pending his arraignment on a future date.

Emmanuel Colon, age 26, of 234 Bailey Street Third Floor Apartment, Lawrence, Massachusetts was arrested for three counts of Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug, Heroin, Felony, stemming from a drug investigation within the city of Nashua. 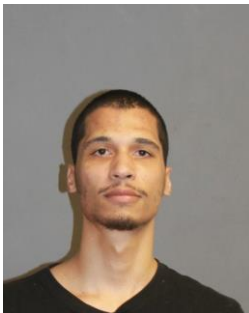

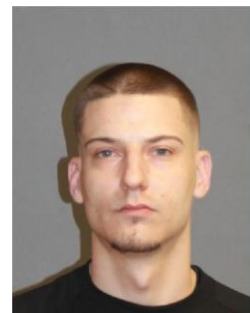

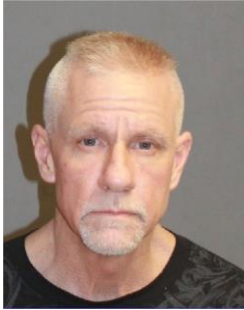
