On July 3, 2018 at approximately 11:41 am, Officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniformed Field Operations Bureau took a report of a violation of a Temporary Domestic Violence Protection Order. Roy Fontes, age 40, of 23 Temple Street Apartment 306 Nashua, New Hampshire was identified as the suspect in the investigation.

The investigation was furthered by Detectives assigned to the Special Investigations Division. Upon review of Fonte's criminal record, it was discovered that he was previously convicted of Stalking-Domestic Violence on September 28, 2017 in the 9th Circuit District Division Nashua Court. Due to this conviction, Fontes was subsequently charged with Stalking-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony.

On July 3, 2018 Detectives applied for and were granted an arrest warrant charging Fontes with Stalking-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony. Fontes was located at his residence and he was subsequently placed under arrest.

Fontes was charged with six counts of Stalking – Domestic Violence, Class B Felony. Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Fontes refused bail and he is currently being held at the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections, pending arraignment will be on July 5, 2018.
