New Hampshire Attorney General Joseph A. Foster and Nashua Police Chief Andrew Lavoie announce that the suspicious death in Nashua on Friday, January 6, 2017, has been ruled a homicide.

On January 6, 2017, at approximately 7:24 p.m police responded to a requested welfare check at 32 Kinsley Street, Apartment 1. The body of a deceased male was located in that apartment. That individual has been identified as Javier Rivera Afanador, age 45.

An autopsy was performed on Mr. Afanador's body by the Deputy Chief Medical Examiner of New Hampshire, Jennie Duval. Dr. Duval determined that the cause of Mr. Afanador's death was multiple blunt force trauma to the head and ruled Mr. Afandor's death a homicide.

The investigation into Mr. Afanador's death is ongoing, but there is no indication that there is any risk to the public at this time.
