On January 23, 2023, at 01:48 AM, members of the Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested James Frye, age 60, of 1 D Street, Nashua, New Hampshire. James Frye was arrested for First Degree Assault and Resisting Arrest/Detention.

On January 23, 2023, at approximately 12:38 AM, members of the Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to a downtown residential address for the report of a male who had been stabbed in the leg. Officers arrived on scene and confirmed that a male victim had been stabbed twice in the leg. That male was transported to a local area hospital for treatment. His injuries were considered non-life threatening. Patrol Officers were able to successfully negotiate the surrender of James Frye from the residence, who was placed under arrest.

Detectives from the Criminal Investigation Division furthered this incident and subsequently charged James Frye with two counts of First Degree Assault, both Class A Felonies, and one count of Resisting Arrest/Detention, a Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to 1 year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. James Frye was held on Preventative Detention, pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court - Southern District on January 24, 2023.
