On Thursday March 9, 2017 at approximately 9:13 P.M., members of the Nashua Police Department Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Jonathan Mainguy, age 31, of 73 Ash Street, Nashua, New Hampshire for four (4) counts of Forgery, Class B Felony and two (2) counts of Theft by Deception, Class A Misdemeanors.

On February 2, 2017 Fraud Investigators from Granite State Credit Union reported a male had deposited two (2) bad checks at various Credit Unions in Nashua, New Hampshire using the "Shared Branching Network". Throughout the investigation Officers identified Jonathan Mainguy as the male who entered the Credit Unions and passed the bad checks then withdrew the money totaling in \$1,500.00 USD.

Additionally, on February 16, 2017 Fraud Investigators from Service Credit Union reported a male had deposited four (4) bad checks at various Credit Unions in Nashua, New Hampshire using the "Shared Branching Network". Throughout the investigation, Officers identified Jonathan Mainguy as the male who entered the Credit Unions and passed the bad checks then withdrew money totaling in \$775.00 USD. Officers subsequently completed an arrest warrant charging Mainguy with Forgery, Class B Felony.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by one year in the house of corrections, exclusive of fines. Mainguy bail was released on \$340 cash bail and he is scheduled to appear at the 9th Circuit District Division Nashua Court on April 21, 2017.
