On April 13, 2017 at approximately 5:00 pm members of the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division arrested Stephen Gill, age 40, of 317 Boston Road Billerica, Massachusetts, for Duty to Inform, Class A Felony.

Stephen Gill was convicted of Felonious Sexual Assault, Class A Felony, in Merrimack County Superior Court in 1996. Based on that conviction, Gill is required to register with the New Hampshire Sex Offender Registry twice a year and he is required to notify the Registry of any change of address.

In March of 2017, Nashua detectives learned that Gill moved from the address he provided and failed to inform the Nashua Police Department or the New Hampshire Sex Offender Registry. Detectives investigated and determined Gill was non-compliant with the terms of the Sex Offender Registry. Based on the investigation, detectives applied for and were granted an arrest warrant for Gill.

Because Gill was previously convicted of Duty to Report on September 28, 2017 in Hillsborough County Superior Court – South, any subsequent offense is charged as a Class A Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines for each count. Stephen Gill was released on bail pending his arraignment at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on June 1, 2017.
