On April 25th, 2017 at approximately 1:11 PM, Officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Shaun Jerome, age 39, of no fixed address, on a warrant for Robbery, Class B Felony.

On April 11th, 2017, the Nashua Police Department received a report of a domestic disturbance at a downtown residence. Officers made contact with an adult female who reported she was assaulted by her ex-boyfriend identified as Shaun Jerome. The female reported Jerome demanded money from her and she refused to give it to him. Jerome then forcefully took the woman's purse from her and took money out. When the woman attempted to take her money back from Jerome, a struggle ensued. The woman sustained an injured arm in the struggle and sought treatment at a Nashua hospital. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation and obtained a warrant for Jerome for Robbery, Class B Felony. Because the injury to the woman's arm was serious, Jerome was charged with Second Degree Assault – Domestic Violence, Class B Felony. Additionally, Jerome was charged with Theft by Unauthorized Taking, Class A Misdemeanor.

Jerome was arrested in Chelmsford, Massachusetts on April 22, 2017 and after waiving extradition was transported to the Nashua Police Department. Jerome refused bail and is being held pending his arraignment in the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to one year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Jerome refused bail and his arraignment will be at the 9th Circuit - District Division - Nashua Court on April 26th, 2017.
