On November 8, 2017, members of the Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division, Problem Oriented Policing Unit, and Traffic Unit participated in Operation Granite Shield where seven individuals were arrested for various drug crimes, and various crimes frequently associated with criminal behavior related to drug activity. These individuals were: Christopher Peak, Christopher Freeman-Benjamin, Virgin Cardona, David Torres, Adam Parker, Zuleika Cintron-Rosario and Jesus Collazo.

Christopher Peak, age 48, of 15 Railroad Square, Apartment 10, Nashua, NH was arrested on November 8, 2017 and charged with two counts of Acts Prohibited; Sale of Controlled Drug, Crack Cocaine, Felony. Peak was held on \$50,000.00 cash bail and is scheduled for arraignment on November 9, 2017.

Christopher Freeman-Benjamin, age 28, of No Fixed Address was arrested on November 8, 2017 and charged with Acts Prohibited; Sale of a Controlled Drug, Crack Cocaine, Felony. Freeman-Benjamin was held on \$30,000 cash bail and is scheduled for arraignment on November 9, 2017.

Virgin Cardona, age 48, of No Fixed Address was arrested on November 8, 2017 and charged with Criminal Liability to the Conduct of Another; Acts Prohibited; Sale of a Controlled Drug, Crack Cocaine, Felony. Cardona was held on \$25,000 cash bail and is scheduled for arraignment on November 9, 2017.

David Torres, age 29, of 82 West Hollis Street Apt D, Nashua, NH was arrested on November 8, 2017 and charged with two counts of Acts Prohibited; Sale of Controlled Drug, Crack Cocaine, Felony. Torres was released on \$20,000 cash or surety bail. He is scheduled to be arraigned December 18, 2017.

Adam Parker, age 37, of South Street Apt C, Milford, NH was arrested on November 8, 2017 and charged with two counts of Acts Prohibited; Sale of Controlled Drug, Heroin, Felony and one count of Acts Prohibited; Sale of Controlled Drug, Cocaine, Felony. Parker refused bail and is scheduled for arraignment on November 9, 2017.

Zuleika Cintron-Rosario, age 35, of 38 Perham Street 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Nashua, NH was arrested on November 8, 2017 and charged with four counts of Acts Prohibited; Sale of a Controlled Drug, Crack Cocaine, Felony and one count of Acts Prohibited; Possession of a Controlled Drug, Cocaine, Felony. Cintron-Rosario was held on \$100,000 cash bail and is scheduled for arraignment on November 9, 2017.

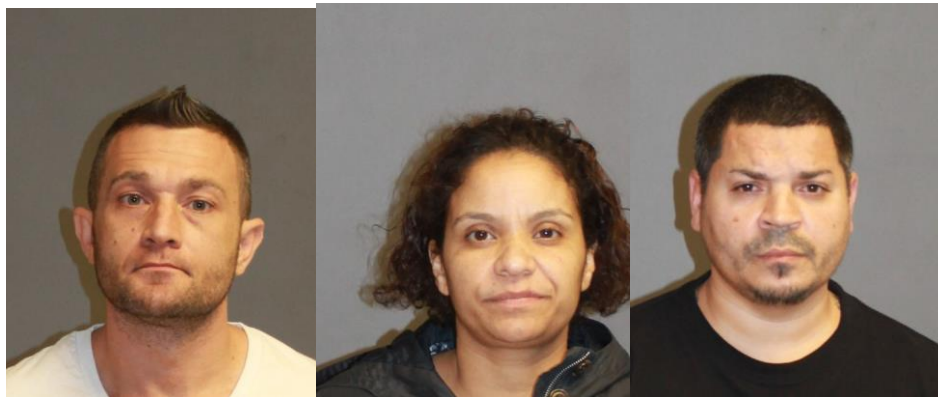
