New Hampshire Attorney General Gordon J. MacDonald and Nashua Police Chief Andrew J. Lavoie announce that there is an on-going investigation into a suspicious death in Nashua at 19 Buck Street. Around midnight, Nashua Police responded to a 911 call at the home, where they discovered a deceased male later identified as David Smith, age 49, of Nashua. An autopsy has been scheduled by the Chief Medical Examiner's Office for Monday, July 9, 2018.

This incident is being investigated by the Attorney General's Office and the Nashua Police Department. As this is an unfolding investigation, additional information will be provided as soon as possible. At this juncture, there is no evidence to suggest that there is any threat of harm to the general public.
