On January 14, 2018 at 6:53 pm officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniformed Field Operations Bureau responded to an address in Nashua for the report of a domestic disturbance. Jonathan Coffin, age 55, of 47 Temple Street was arrested by patrol officers and charged with Simple Assault-Domestic Violence, Class A Misdemeanor.

The investigation was furthered by Detectives assigned to the Special Investigations Division. The victim, known to Coffin, sustained non-life threatening physical injuries during the incident and received treatment from a nearby medical facility. Based on the investigation, Coffin was charged with Second Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony, Simple Assault-Domestic Violence, Class A Misdemeanor, and Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to 1 year in County Jail. Coffin is being held on \$5,000 cash bail at the Hillsborough County House of Corrections in Manchester, NH pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on January 16, 2018.
