On June 10, 2019 at 7:22 PM, the Nashua Police Department arrested Joshua Carrasquillo, age 37, of 170 Hollis Street, Pepperell, Massachusetts. Carrasquillo is charged with Certain Uses of Computer Services Prohibited, Attempted Felonious Sexual Assault and Falsifying Physical Evidence, all Class B Felonies.

In late May 2019, members of the Nashua Police Department and the New Hampshire Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force participated in Operation Cyber Guardian and as a result launched an investigation into a male who was communicating with a person he believed to be a juvenile regarding sexual contact between them. During the course of this investigation, the subject agreed to travel to Nashua on June 10, 2019 to engage in sexual contact with the person he believed to be a juvenile. As a result of the investigation, Carrasquillo was arrested after traveling from his home and arriving in Nashua to meet the person he believed to be a juvenile. He also is charged with deleting a mobile application used in this communication believing that the police were about to institute an investigation.

Each class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Carrasquillo is currently being held on \$5,000 cash only bail pending his arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on June 11, 2019.
