On Sunday April 22, 2018 at 3:07 pm officers arrested Brian McPherson, age 57, of 10 Boulder Circle Nashua, New Hampshire for: Resisting Arrest/Detention, Class A Misdemeanor; Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor; Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony and Possession of a Controlled Drug (Marijuana) with Intent to Distribute, Felony.

On April 22, 2018 a victim reported being physically assaulted and threatened by someone after he pulled his vehicle over after a road rage incident. Detectives from the Criminal Investigations Division furthered the investigation and identified McPherson as the suspect. The investigation revealed that McPherson physically assaulted and threatened the victim while McPherson possessed a handgun. Officers responded to McPherson's residence where they attempted to make contact with McPherson. After a period of time communicating with McPherson he exited the residence and was taken into custody. During the course of the investigation a quantity of marijuana was located which resulted in charge of possession of a controlled drug with the intent to distribute.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven (7) years in State Prison, exclusive of fines, and a Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to one (1) year in the County House of Corrections exclusive of fines. McPherson was released from the Nashua Police Department on \$10,000.00 cash or surety bail and is scheduled for an arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on May 10, 2018.
