On June 27, 2018 at approximately 5:26 PM, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau, Patrol Division, arrested Edward Salie, age 26, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Duty to Inform, a Class A Felony.

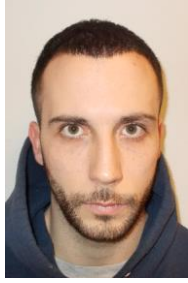
The Nashua Police Department was notified that a convicted Sex Offender gave false information on his quarterly registration with the Nashua Police Department. An investigation was initiated by the Special Investigations Division. Following the Detective's investigation, it was determined that Salie gave false information on his quarterly registration with the Nashua Police Department on two separate occasions and a warrant was obtained for his arrest. Salie was charged with two counts of Duty to Inform, a Class A Felony.

Salie was convicted of Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault from Hillsborough County Superior Court South on January 6, 2012. Based on that conviction, Salie is required to register quarterly as a Tier III Sex Offender for the remainder of his life. Salie was also convicted of Duty to Report on February 27, 2013 from Hillsborough County Superior Court South in Nashua, New Hampshire. Thus any subsequent offense of Duty to Report or Duty to Inform is a Class A Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Salie's bail was set at \$10,000 Cash/Surety and is being held pending his arraignment on June 28, 2018.
