On May 4, 2018 at approximately 6:11 pm, members from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Leanne McKinnon, age 21, of 86.5 Ash Street, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant charging her with Felonious Sexual Assault, Class B Felony; Jonathan Martin, age 28, of 86.5 Ash Street, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant charging him with Felonious Sexual Assault, Class B Felony; Lukos Ceurvels, age 20, of 28 Railroad Square, apt 35, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant charging him with Felonious Sexual Assault, Class B Felony and Michael Come Jr, age 27, of 32 Paxton Terrace, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant charging him with Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault, Class A Felony.

On March 30, 2018, a Detective from the Special Investigations Division along with several members of the United States Marshals Service were attempting to locate a wanted individual within a residence in Nashua, New Hampshire. Consent was received to search the residence and it was discovered that a fifteen year old juvenile was in bed with a twenty seven year old male. The fifteen year old juvenile was interviewed and provided several names of individuals she had a sexual relationship with. The investigation was furthered by Detectives from the Special Investigations Division. Based on that investigation, arrest warrants were obtained for the above individuals. McKinnon was charged with a total of five counts of Felonious Sexual Assault, Class B Felony; Martin was charged with a total of two counts of Felonious Sexual Assault, Class B Felony; Ceurvels was charged with four counts of Felonious Sexual Assault, Class B Felony and Come Jr was charged with two counts of Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault, Class A Felony.

Each Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Each Class B Felony is punishable up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. McKinnon's bail was set at \$25,000 cash or surety; Martin's bail was set at \$25,000 cash or surety; Ceurvels' bail was set at \$50,000 cash or surety and Come Jr's bail was set at \$50,000 cash only. All four individuals were arraigned on May 4, 2018.
