On April 24, 2017 at 11:52 pm the Nashua Police Department's Traffic Enforcement Unit arrested Jose Gomez, 31, of 570 172<sup>nd</sup> Street, Apartment 1D, New York City, New York for one count of Identity Fraud, Class A Felony.

On April 21, 2017, uniformed officers took a report of an Identity Fraud. The identity stolen was used purchase two phones online from AT&T. The officer's investigation revealed that the phones were being shipped to the Holiday Inn at 9 Northeastern Boulevard, Nashua on April 24, 2017. Members of the Traffic Enforcement Unit furthered this investigation. It was also learned that the suspect had booked a room at the Holiday Inn under the identity fraud victim's name. Members of the Problem Oriented Policing Unit and Detective Bureau conducted surveillance of this hotel and identified the shipped package. At approximately 11:40 PM, members of the Traffic Enforcement Unit observed a subject picking up this package containing the phones. This individual was detained and was later identified as Jose Gomez. Gomez had additionally obtained a fraudulent Connecticut driver's license with the identity fraud victim's information and used it to obtain this package.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Gomez was held on \$5,000 cash bail and will be arraigned at the 9th Circuit-District Division- Nashua Court on April 25, 2017.
