On June 3, 2018 at approximately 3:09 a.m., officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniformed Field Operations Bureau arrested Timothy Webster, age 22, of Nashua, New Hampshire for First Degree Assault-Domestic Violence.

On June 3, 2018 at approximately 1:49 a.m., officers responded to a residence in Nashua for a domestic dispute. A male party known to Webster was found to have a head wound. The victim declined medical attention. Based on statements made by those involved and Officer's observations, Webster was arrested. The investigation was furthered by Detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division and Webster was ultimately charged with First Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class A Felony and six counts of Domestic Violence-Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Each Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Webster is being held on \$10,000 cash or surety bail pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on June 4, 2018.
