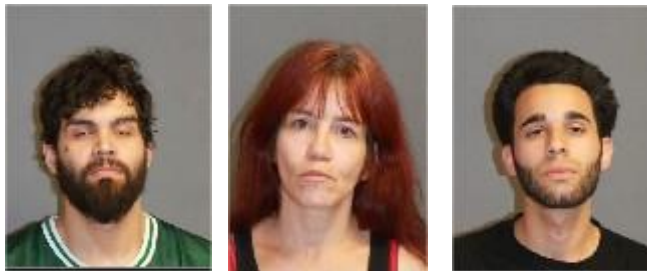

During the week of June 20, 2017, members of the Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division, Problem Oriented Policing Unit and Traffic Unit participated in Operation Granite Hammer. Numerous individuals were arrested for various drug crimes and various crimes frequently associated with criminal behavior related to drug activity. These individuals were: Kevin Burgos-Santiago, Toni Flaherty and Alejandro Garcia.

Kevin Burgos-Santiago, age 29 of 77 Lock Street, Nashua NH, was arrested and charged with Acts Prohibited, Possession of a Controlled Drug Second Offense, Fentanyl, Felony, Falsifying Physical Evidence, Felony and a Capias for Sale of a Controlled Drug Fentanyl. Burgos-Santiago will face an enhanced penalty for having a prior drug conviction.

Toni Flaherty, age 45 of 12 Burke Street, Nashua NH, was arrested on a warrant completed by detectives in the Narcotics Intelligence Division. Flaherty was charged with Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug, Crack Cocaine, Second Offense, Felony and Theft by Unauthorized Taking, Misdemeanor. Flaherty will face an enhanced penalty for having a prior drug conviction.

Alejandro Garcia, age 22 of 12 Beech Street Apt. 8, Nashua NH, was arrested on a warrant completed by detectives in the Narcotics Intelligence Division. Garcia was charged with Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug, Cocaine, Second Offense, Felony. Garcia will face an enhanced penalty for having a prior drug conviction.
