On July 27, 2017, at approximately 9:44am, members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Jeremy Tappan, age 28, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, NH, for Receiving Stolen Property, Class B Felony, Theft by Unauthorized Taking or Transfer, Class A Misdemeanor and on an out town Warrant from the Hudson, NH Police Department.

On June 27, 2017 at approximately 2:36pm, members of the Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to Best Buy, 220 Daniel Webster Highway for a report of a male that stole 4 XBOX controllers. Officers then furthered the investigation and learned that after the 4 XBOX controllers were stolen, they were then pawned at Good Deeds, 300 Main Street in Nashua, NH. Patrol officers then identified the male subject as Jeremy Tappan who stole the 4 XBOX controllers and then pawned the 4 XBOX controllers at Good Deeds.

An arrest warrant was applied for and granted charging Tappan with Receiving Stolen Property, Class B Felony as it was learned that Tappan had been previously convicted of two theft related offenses which upgraded the Receiving Stolen Property to a Class B, Felony.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to 1 year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Tappan's bail was set at \$20,000 cash and he is scheduled to appear at arraignment at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on July 28, 2017.
