On October 8, 2018 Officers from the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing Unit arrested Jean Yazbek, age 63, of 4 Westview Drive, Norwood, Massachusetts and Michael Soby, age 59, of 9 Marie Avenue, Pelham, New Hampshire for one count each of Certain Uses of Computer Services Prohibited, Class B Felony.

On October 2, 2018, members of the Criminal Investigation Division conducted an investigation into a male who was communicating with a person he believed to be a child regarding sexual contact between them using an on-line social media website. During the course of this investigation, Jean Yazbek was developed as a suspect. As a result of the investigation, on October 8, 2018 at approximately 3:42 PM, Yazbek was arrested after traveling to Nashua to meet the person he believed to be a child. Yazbek was charged with 1 count of Certain Uses of Computer Services Prohibited, Class B Felony.

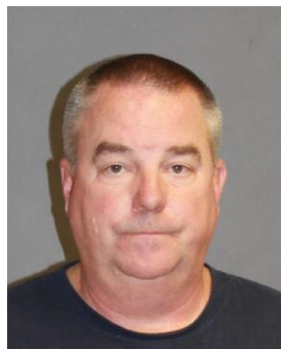
On October 8, 2018, members of the Criminal Investigation Division conducted an investigation into a male who was communicating with a person he believed to be a child regarding sexual contact between them using an on-line social media website. During the course of this investigation, Michael Soby was developed as a suspect. As a result of the investigation, on October 8, 2018 at approximately 5:15 PM, Soby was arrested after traveling to Nashua to meet the person he believed to be a child. Soby was charged with 1 count of Certain Uses of Computer Services Prohibited, Class B Felony.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Yazbek and Soby were released on \$500.00 cash only bail pending their arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court - South on October 18, 2018.
