On May 2, 2017 at approximately 11:52 am, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniformed Field Operations Bureau arrested Adam Larose, age 34, of 5 Girourd Avenue, Nashua, New Hampshire and charged him with Second Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony.

On May 2, 2017 at approximately 7:26 am, patrol officers responded to a local hospital for a report of an assault. A male related to Larose reported that Larose assaulted him at a Nashua residence. The male sustained multiple injuries and sought treatment for them at a Nashua hospital. The investigation was furthered by detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division. It was determined the male was struck and pushed multiple times by Larose. As a result of the assault, the male sustained numerous fractures to his torso and facial area. The injuries were deemed serious, but non-life threatening, however based on the severity of the injuries the male was transferred to a Boston area hospital to receive further medical treatment.

Larose was arrested and charged with Second Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony and Second Degree Assault, Class B Felony.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in Prison, exclusive of fines. Larose is being held at the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections on \$50,000 cash bail, pending his arraignment on May 3, 2017.
