On October 9, 2020 at 8:45 A.M., members of the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigation Division and Criminal Investigation Division, arrested Wesley Fernandez Heredia, age 27, of 117 Cimarron Drive, Apartment D15, Seabrook, New Hampshire. Fernandez Heredia is charged with Certain Uses of Computer Services Prohibited and Attempted Felonious Sexual Assault, both Class B Felonies.

In September of 2020 members of the Special Investigation Division began an investigation into the sexual exploitation of children on the internet where a subject, identified as Fernandez Heredia, was communicating with a person he believed to be a child. As a result of the investigation, on October 9, 2020 Fernandez Heredia was arrested in Nashua.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Fernandez Heredia was released on personal recognizance bail and will appear in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South at a future date.

The Nashua Police Department is an affiliate of the Internet Crimes against Children (ICAC) Task Force, working to combat child exploitation in New Hampshire.
