On April 4, 2018, members of the Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division, Problem Oriented Policing Unit and Traffic Unit conducted another operation as part of the Granite Shield program where five individuals were arrested for drug-related crimes. These individuals were:

Jose Mendez, Age 32, of 11 Monmouth Street, Lawrence, Massachusetts was charged with one count of Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug, Crack Cocaine, Second Offense, Felony. Mendez will face enhanced penalties due to his prior drug conviction. Mendez was held on \$50,000 cash bail and will be arraigned on April 5, 2018.

Lewis Clark, Age 40, of No Fixed Address, was charged with one count of Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug, Cocaine, Second Offense, Felony. Clark will face enhanced penalties due to his prior drug conviction. Lewis was held on \$30,000 cash bail and will be arraigned on April 5, 2018.

Andrew Sanders, Age 33, of 21 Cambridge Road, Nashua was charged with one count of Acts Prohibited, Possession on a Controlled Drug, Methamphetamine, Felony and one count of Acts Prohibited, Possession of a Controlled Drug, Heroin, Felony. Sanders was released on \$750 cash bail and will be arraigned on April 26, 2018.

Natasha Davis, Age 30, of 3 Amory Street, Apartment 1, Nashua was charged with one count of Prostitution, Class A Misdemeanor. Davis was released on \$5000 personal recognizance bail and will be arraigned on April 26, 2018.

Rigoberto Gaud, Age 24, of 87 River Road, Pittsfield, New Hampshire was charged with one count of Habitual Offender, Class B Felony. Gaud was released on \$400 cash bail and will be arraigned on April 26, 2018.

These arrests came at the conclusion of extensive investigations into the distribution of illegal drugs in Nashua and were made possible through funding provided by the Granite Shield program.



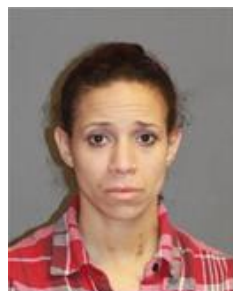
