On June 4, 2019 at 1:32pm, members of the Nashua Police Department arrested Marques Menard, age 26, of 89 Pine Street #C, Nashua, New Hampshire. Menard is charged with three counts of Burglary, Class B Felony, Consolidated Theft by Deception, Class B Felony and an Electronic Bench Warrant.

On November 7, 2018 at approximately 1:49pm, officers responded to Finish Line, 310 Daniel Webster Highway for a report of a Burglary. It was reported Menard, a former employee, had entered the business without authorization during non-business hours to steal money on three separate occasions in November 2018. It was also reported that Menard conducted several fraudulent return transactions in September and October 2018 while employed at the business.

Detectives furthered and obtained an arrest warrant charging Menard. At the time of his arrest Menard had an active Electronic Bench Warrant for failure to appear in court on an unrelated case.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Menard was released on Personal Recognizance and is scheduled to appear for arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on June 20, 2019.
