On June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at approximately 10:56 PM, the Nashua Police Department arrested Everett Rice, age 25, of 18 Paxton Terrace for Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony; Domestic Violence Class B Felony; 3 counts of Domestic Violence, Class A Misdemeanor; and 3 counts of Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor.

On June 29, 2017 at 10:17pm the Nashua Police Department received a report of a domestic disturbance at a Nashua residence. Members from the Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded and spoke with an adult male who reported that he was physically assaulted. The male stated his relative, Everett Rice, was involved in a minor altercation with another male. The victim stated he broke up the altercation between his relative and the other male, but then his relative began fighting with the victim. Everett Rice struck the victim several times and threatened him with a knife. The victim sustained minor injuries, but did not require medical treatment. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation and Rice was charged with Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony; Domestic Violence Class B Felony: 3 counts of Domestic Violence, Class A Misdemeanor; and 3 counts of Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to one year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Rice was released on \$10,000.00 cash or surety bail pending his arraignment at the 9th Circuit - District Division - Nashua Court on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
