On Saturday February 2, 2019 at approximately 2:20pm members of the Nashua Police arrested Lindsey Tierno, age 29, of 15 Gillis Street, Nashua, New Hampshire, for one count of Falsifying Physical Evidence, Class B Felony.

In May of 2016 Nashua Police responded to a residence on East Dunstable Road for the report of an overdose. On scene patrol officers made contact with a female victim who was transported to a local hospital by medical personnel. A few days later the female victim passed away at the hospital from what was ruled an accidental overdose of fentanyl and ethanol.

Detectives from the Criminal Investigation Division were notified of this incident and furthered the investigation. It was learned that Lindsey Tierno was at the residence at the time of the overdose and had left prior to the officer's arrival. Tierno is charged with removing evidence from the scene with a purpose to impair its availability in such investigation. An arrest warrant for Tierno was obtained charging her with one count of Falsifying Physical Evidence, Class B Felony.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven (7) years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Tierno was released on personal recognizance bail and is scheduled for arraignment at the 9th Circuit Nashua District Court on March 6, 2019.
