On March 1, 2018 at approximately 11:17 am, Detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division, along with the Lebanon Police Department and the United States Marshall Service arrested Edward Goodwin, age 55, of 86 NH Route 4A Apartment #8, Lebanon, NH and charged him with one count of Felonious Sexual Assault, Class B Felony and one count of Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault, Class A Felony.

In April of 2014 the Nashua Police Department began investigating a past Felonious Sexual Assault involving a juvenile under the age of 13. The victim reported that she was inappropriately touched by Edward Goodwin at a residence in Nashua, New Hampshire. In November of 2015, during the course of the previous investigation, another victim came forward reporting that Goodwin sexually assaulted him. The victim, who was under the age of 13 at the time of the assaults, reported he was forced to engage in a pattern of sexual assaults by Goodwin.

Goodwin, who is a registered sex offender, had left the Nashua area during the time of these investigations. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division learned of Goodwin's whereabouts and obtained an arrest warrant charging him with Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years in New Hampshire State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in New Hampshire State Prison, exclusive of fines. Goodwin was held on \$100,000.00 cash bail pending his arraignment at the 9th Circuit Court District of Nashua on March 2, 2018.
