On April 12, 2017 at approximately 10:35 am members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Operations Bureau arrested Zuleyka Torres, age 29, of 6 West Burnside Avenue, Lowell, Massachusetts on a warrant for Forgery, Class B Felony.

On August 8, 2013 the Nashua Police Department received a report of fraudulent financial transactions that occurred at two banks in Nashua in August of 2013. Detectives from the Criminal Investigation Division were notified and furthered the investigation. Torres was identified as the suspect and it was determined she forged two checks and cashed them at Nashua banks. One check was forged and cashed for \$3500.00 and a second check was forged and cashed for \$4300.00. In December of 2013 detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Torres for Forgery, Class B Felony.

On April 12, 2017, Torres reported to the Nashua Police Department and turned herself in on the warrant. A second Forgery, Class B Felony charge was brought forward at the time of her arrest.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines for each count. Zuleyka Torres was released on \$2,000.00 Personal Recognizance bail. She is scheduled for arraignment at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on May 26, 2017.
