On January 17, 2017 at approximately 9:45 am, members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Lee Ann Houle, age 46, of 4 Prospect Ave #2 Nashua, NH on warrant for Theft by Deception (Consolidation), Class A Felony. She was additionally charged with Theft by Unauthorized Taking (Consolidation), Class A Felony.

On July 29, 2016 at approximately 11:55 am, the Nashua Police Department received a report of an internal Theft that occurred at Rite Aid 331 Main Street Nashua. The Loss Prevention Manager reported the theft involved an employee processing fake returns and keeping the money.

Detectives from the Criminal Investigation Division furthered the investigation. The investigation revealed that in addition to fraudulent returns, Houle was stealing merchandise off of the shelves which resulted in the additional Theft by Unauthorized Taking (Consolidation) charge.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Houle was released on \$25,000 personal recognizance bail and will be arraigned at the 9th Circuit-District Division- Nashua Court on March 3, 2017.
