On December 30, 2016 at 3:45 PM, members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operation Bureau arrested Nicholas Boucher, age 22, of 46 Vine Street, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant. He was charged with six counts of Reckless Conduct-Deadly Weapon, Class B Felony, Felon in Possession of a Deadly Weapon, Class B Felony, and Criminal Mischief, Class A Misdemeanor.

On January 5, 2017 at approximately 3:40 PM, members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operation Bureau arrested Michael Kenyon, age 23, of 48 Pelham Road, Hudson, New Hampshire on a warrant. He was charged with Criminal Liability to Reckless Conduct, Class B Felony, and Criminal Liability to Criminal Mischief, Class A Misdemeanor.

On October 22, 2016 members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operation's Bureau responded to Amory Street for the report of shots fired. The Nashua Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division then furthered the investigation, Boucher was determined to be the shooter, and Kenyon was identified as the driver.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines, and a Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Boucher is currently being held at Hillsborough County House of Corrections on \$50,000 cash or surety bail and was arraigned at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on January 3, 2016. Kenyon was released on \$2,500 cash or surety bail pending his arraignment at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on February 16, 2017.
