On August 21, 2017 at approximately 9:59 AM, officers from the Nashua Police Department arrested Amy Deschenes, age 37, of 20 D Street Apt. A, Nashua, New Hampshire and charged her with Criminal Mischief, Class A Misdemeanor.

On August 21, 2017 at approximately 9:41 AM, patrol officers responded to a residence in Nashua for the report of an assault. Upon arrival officers met with a male who reported his ex-girlfriend, Amy Deschenes, while armed with a baseball bat, threatened him, struck him and damaged his vehicle. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division were notified and furthered the investigation. Based on their investigation, Deschenes was additionally charged with Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor; Domestic Violence: Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor; Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony; Domestic Violence: Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony; and Reckless Conduct, Class B Felony. The victim sustained minor injuries. The vehicle had a window smashed out and was dented by Deschenes.

Each Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in Prison, exclusive of fines. Deschenes was released on \$1,000 cash bail, pending her arraignment on August 22, 2017.
