On May 9th, 2017 at approximately 5:07 PM members of the Nashua Police Department Uniform Patrol Division arrested Steven Fleury, age 36, of 16 Central Street Apartment #1, Nashua, New Hampshire, for Operating after being certified as a Habitual Offender, Special Felony, Possession of a Controlled Drug, a Class B Felony, Driving Without Giving Proof, a Class A Misdemeanor, and Endangering the Welfare of a Child, a Class A Misdemeanor.

On May 9th Nashua Police Department Patrol Officers conducted a motor vehicle stop in the area of Bridge Street for a motor vehicle inspection violation. Officers determined that Fleury, who was the operator of the vehicle, was a Habitual Offender and he was then taken into custody. During the course of the investigation it was later learned that prior to Fleury being taken into custody he had provided a juvenile, who had been in the vehicle, a controlled drug in an attempt to evade police detection. As a result he was additionally charged with Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Class A Misdemeanor, and Possession of a Controlled Drug, Class B Felony, charges was added.

A Special Felony is punishable by up to 5 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year of imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Fleury was held on \$25,000.00 cash only bail pending his arraignment at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on April 10th, 2017.
