On Monday March 12, 2018 at approximately 3:15 p.m., members of the Nashua Police Department Problem Oriented Police (POP) Unit arrested Luis Santos, age 46, of 4 Fossa Avenue Apartment C, Nashua, New Hampshire, for one count of Robbery, Class A Felony.

On March 12, 2018 at approximately 11:59 a.m., officers responded to the Lake Convenience Store for the report of a robbery involving a handgun. The clerk reported being robbed and the suspect had fled after receiving money from the register. The suspect was described as a male wearing a black mask, brown jacket, and armed with a black handgun. The suspect was last seen running east on Lake Street.

Detectives with assistance of patrol officers furthered the investigation and were able to identify the suspect as Luis Santos. Members of the POP Unit subsequently located Santos and he was placed under arrest for one count of Armed Robbery, Class A Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen (15) years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Santos refused bail and was held at the Hillsborough House of Corrections pending arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court South on March 13, 2018.
